Supporting young artists for the sixth year: The Adrian Carruthers Studio Award 2007/2008

The award for 2007/2008 has been given to Slade postgraduate student **Terumitsu Hishinuma**.

The selection panel included Slade Professor John Aiken and Heads of Department John Hilliard, Edward Allington and Estelle Thompson. Painter Dan Perfect was this year's external selector.

Terumitsu studied Architecture at Musashino University in Japan before completing his MFA at the Slade in the Sculpture School. He has been working in the studio at Childers Street since October 2007.

"I am really full of a sense of wonder to be this year's Adrian Carruthers Studio Award holder. It brings me a wonderful space, the time and financial assistance to continue and further develop my work as a professional artist.
