

Summary of local council Additional Restrictions Grants (ARG's) for Acme artist tenants.

(Last edited: 11 March 2021)

The Additional Restrictions Grant (ARG) provides local councils with grant funding to support closed businesses that do not directly pay business rates as well as businesses impacted by Lockdown restrictions.

Each council scheme places varying emphasis on the type of business they hope to support, the level of grant offered and the application process.

Summary of local council provisions listed below in alphabetical order:

1. Hackney – open

Deadline Friday 12 March 2021

Eligibility: Micro and small businesses based in commercial premises in Hackney that were not legally required to close during the December tier restrictions or the current national lockdown but have been **severely impacted** by the restrictions put in place to control the spread of Covid-19 (either with or without a Hackney business rates account).

2. Hammersmith & Fulham – closed

3. Lambeth – closed

(Lambeth council refer to the scheme as the Economic Resilience Fund)

4. Lewisham – open

Deadline 31 March 2021

Grants are available to business in all sectors however they have identified priority areas for support including “*Shared workspaces - Small businesses and social enterprises in shared offices or other flexible workspaces which do not have their own business rates assessment with a rateable value of less than £51,000*”

You will need to have had an income of at least £10,000 per annum in the year 2019/20 tax year to be eligible. Grants are being awarded on a first come first served basis.

Deadline 15 March 2021

The Newham scheme is only open to those who can demonstrate they are a key supplier to businesses in retail, hospitality, events and leisure sectors.

Deadline 31 March 2021

Eligibility: Registered self-employed or small businesses with a turnover of at least £6,000 per annum during 2019/20 tax year, and have lost at least 30% of your income/turnover as a result of national and Tier 4 restrictions.
