

Local Authority Discretionary Grant Fund - Southwark

11 June 2020

Applications opened Monday 8 June. They will be processing applications by order received until the funds are spent.

As a studio holder in Southwark you can consider making an application if you are registered as a sole trader, self-employed, or limited company and you have had a fall in income since 11 March 2020.

The grants available are up to £2500 and can be applied for to help with rent charges and other essential running or business costs.

To apply

You will need to upload:

- Evidence of ongoing property-related costs such as a copy of your tenancy or Acme can provide you with a rent statement
- Evidence of loss of income, e.g. business cash flow records, and/or
- Bank statements covering the period 1 January 2020 to 30 May 2020 for the account into which you would like any grant to be paid, and/or
- Xero / Sage / Quickbooks or equivalent Profit and Loss summary from April 2019 to March 2020
- Evidence to support any costs you wish to claim the grant for
